



Introduction:

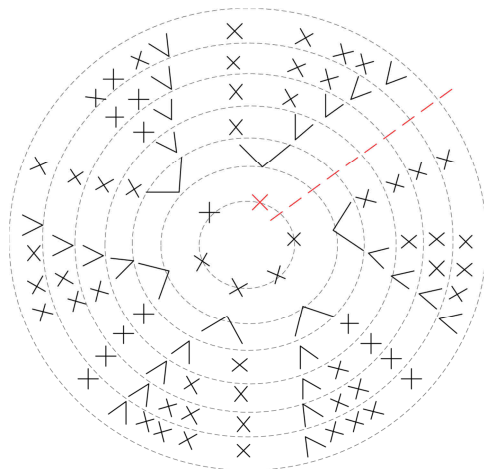
- Ⓢ Size:
Depends on the yarn and hook sizes you are using, approximately 4.5 cm/ 1.8".
- Ⓢ Skill level:
Beginner.
You should be familiar with crocheting in rounds with slip stitch and basic stitches.
There are no basic crochet tutorials included.

Important Note:

- Ⓢ If you started the sequence and the row(round) is finished, continue the sequence until the end, unless otherwise stated.
- Ⓢ The remaining project will be worked in continuous rounds (spirals), so there's no joining at the end of the round. You also may wish to use a marker to keep track of your rounds.
- Ⓢ Please read the graphic chart counter-clockwise.
- Ⓢ The pillow will be crocheted with slip stitch techniques.
- Ⓢ Red color indicates the first chain/stitch.

Side A:



- Ⓢ Rnd 1: Make a magic ring. Crochet 6 ch (6 Stitches in total).



- Ⓢ Rnd 2: [1 SC Inc]*6 (12 SC total).
- Ⓢ Rnd 3: [1 SC Inc, 1 SC]*6 (3 SC in the sequins, 18 SC total).

- Ⓢ Rnd 4: [1 SC Inc, 2 SC]*6 (4 SC in the sequins, 24 SC total).
- Ⓢ Rnd 5: [1 SC Inc, 3 SC]*6 (5 SC in the sequins, 30 SC total).
- Ⓢ Rnd 6: [1 SC Inc, 4 SC]*6 (6 SC in the sequins, 36 SC total).



Golden Coins

Step-by-step detailed tutorial

Materials:

- Ⓢ Crochet hook, size 2.5 mm.
- Ⓢ Metallic gold tating thread, size 20. I put 7 threads together.
- Ⓢ Akrylon or other type of fiberfill.
- Ⓢ Scissors .
- Ⓢ Needle.

Abbreviations and symbols:

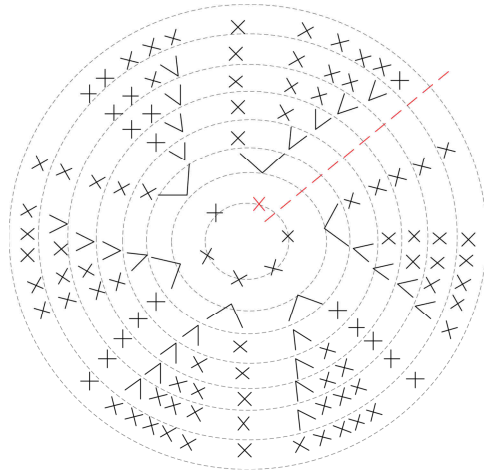
- Ⓢ Ch - chain, symbol O.
- Ⓢ Sl st - Slip stitch - symbol ◦
- Ⓢ SC - Single Crochet, X.
- Ⓢ Rnd - Round.
- Ⓢ SC Inc - SC Increase. Crochet twice into the same stitch, ∨
- Ⓢ St - Stitch.
- Ⓢ Ea - Each.
- Ⓢ [] (brackets) - used to enclosed a sequence meant to be repeated. After the closing brackets will be the number of times to repeat the instruction

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- Ⓢ Do not redistribute, resell and/or translate pattern into another language for reselling, including publishing in the Internet. Do not sell the finished product on the Internet

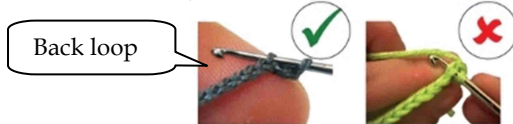


Side B:



- Ⓢ Red color indicates the first stitch.
- Ⓢ Read the graphic chart counter-clockwise.

- Ⓢ Rnd 1: Make a magic ring. Crochet 6 ch (6 Stitches in total).
- Ⓢ Rnd 2: [1 SC Inc]*6 (12 SC total).
- Ⓢ Rnd 3: [1 SC Inc, 1 SC]*6 (3 SC in the sequins, 18 SC total).
- Ⓢ Rnd 4: [1 SC Inc, 2 SC]*6 (4 SC in the sequins, 24 SC total).
- Ⓢ Rnd 5: [1 SC Inc, 3 SC]*6 (5 SC in the sequins, 30 SC total).
- Ⓢ Rnd 6: [1 SC Inc, 4 SC]*6 (6 SC in the sequins, 36 SC total).
- Ⓢ Rnd 7: Crochet this row using back loop crochet style. 36 SC (36 SC total).



Assembly:



- Sew together both parts of the coin and stuff the coin with fiberfill.



- Knot and secure the tail of the threads.
- Squeeze the coin a little bit, to spread the fiberfill equally.
